- Do the committees have a separate budget
 - They are allocated differently
- UGS financially responsive for the awards and will the Awards committee be responsible for decisions?
 - Yes ,UGS is funding awards
 - This year would be a trial period
 - Faculty process: review committee by Trevor
- Is this in writing with UGS? Is there a CFR recommendation how we spend our budget
 - Yes ,this is in writing and will be accessible to representatives
 - CFR will always find a complain and an opinion
- If we do not allocate money now can we change it later?
 - Once we vote it is set in stone
- What was the biggest change from last year's budget?
 - o 1000 for officers
 - Full stipend for 3 SAAS
 - Community building was 1000
 - Travel awards
 - o Debt

 - Proposals to change bylaws
 - This was the last year's discussion
